

Information on data protection

When you register, you declare your consent pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 GDPR that the personal data collected here will be stored and processed for the purpose of holding this event and transmitting event-related information.

With respect to the processing of your personal data, you have the following rights:

- To request access to your personal data from us, pursuant to Art. 15 GDPR.
- To request that we rectify your personal data, pursuant to Art. 16 GDPR. .
- To request that we erase your personal data, pursuant to Art. 17 GDPR.
- To request that we restrict the processing of your personal data, pursuant to Art. 18 GDPR.
- The right to data portability, pursuant to Art. 20 GDPR.

Recipients of personal data

In order to provide the services agreed in connection with your registration, personal data will be transferred to the following recipients:

- Service partners and cooperation partners, for organising and holding the event.
- Online payment service providers, if you pay your participation fee online.

Use of CM.com Stichting / Docdata Payment as online payment service provider

You have the option of paying your participation fee via the online payment service provider CM.com Stichting, Konijnenberg 30, 4825BD, Breda, The Netherlands ("Cm.com Stichting / Docdata"). Personal data will be transmitted to CM.com Stichting / Docdata for this purpose.

The personal data transmitted to CM.com Stichting / Docdata consists of your first name, last name, address, telephone number, e-mail address or other data required to process the registration such as (for example) information about the payment type and means of payment. In addition, data related to your invoice such as (for example) the participation fee, the invoice amount and taxes will also be transferred. This transmission is necessary to process your registration, verify your identity and administer your payment.

Information on the means of payment such as (for example) credit card or account numbers will not be transmitted to Eurokongress GmbH.

Please note that CM.com Stichting / Docdata may also transfer personal data to service providers, sub-contractors or other affiliated companies if this is necessary to perform the contractual obligations arising from your registration or if personal data is to be processed by third parties on behalf of CM.com Stichting / Docdata.
