3. Period of validity of the conditions of participation

These conditions of participation apply from the time of registration for the event, during the event on site and for the subsequent follow-up and any follow-up communication. In particular for the following periods:

- Registration: From receipt of the participant's registration and confirmation by the organizer.
- Event period on site: All activities and procedures during the event, participation in program items and stay at the event location.
- Follow-up: Processing feedback, following up on open points (e.g. sending materials, invoicing), as well as the further processing of image and video material created during the event.

The conditions of participation lose their validity as soon as all processes in connection with the event have been completed and there are no further legal claims arising from the event relationship.

4. Participation requirements and access regulations

Participation is only permitted for persons aged 18 and over.

Registration is reserved exclusively for professionals, industry representatives and other stakeholders in the field of the event. Participants may be asked to provide proof of their status. This can take the form of an ID card or a letter of confirmation from the employer, for example.

Participation in the event is reserved for registered persons only. On-site registration will be offered depending on the event and subject to available capacity. It should be noted that participation in the event is not possible without prior registration.

Access to the event is only possible with the name badge issued by the organizer. Access to specific courses, workshops or similar program items requires prior booking as part of the registration process. Passing on the name badge to third parties is expressly prohibited.

Furthermore, access restrictions may apply to certain areas of the event, in particular in connection with legal requirements for advertising products that are only intended for specific target groups (e.g. professionals).

For compliance reasons, it is not permitted to bring non-registered persons (such as family members or accompanying persons) to the event or to special areas of the event, unless this has been explicitly marked or communicated by the organizer.

By registering, participants confirm that they will comply with the above conditions.

The organizer reserves the right to exclude participants from the event who violate the conditions of participation or behave inappropriately. In this case, there is no entitlement to a refund.

5. Registration and participation

Registration procedure

The contract for participation in the event is concluded by the registration of the participant and the confirmation of this registration by the organizer. The confirmation of registration shall be in writing and shall be sent to the e-mail address provided by the participant during the registration process.

Registration for the event is only possible online. Each participant is responsible for the accuracy of the data provided. The participation fee must be paid online during the registration process, using the payment methods provided. Under certain circumstances, payment by invoice may be agreed. A submitted registration constitutes a binding contractual offer, which is deemed to have been accepted unless the organizer cancels it. By registering, these conditions of participation are accepted.

After submitting the registration, participants have the option of changing or adding their personal data or further bookings, such as additional courses, at any time. Any costs incurred as a result are to be borne by the participant. It is also possible to transfer the registration to another person, but only if the complete and correct details of the new participant are provided. Name badges are personal and cannot be transferred to another person without the prior information and consent of the

organizer. Participants will be informed in good time by e-mail of any changes to their registration status, such as the rejection or adjustment of a booking.

Additional agreements or amendments are only valid if they are recorded in writing.

¹ Participants qualify as **Members** if they have an active membership with **IASP** ([apply here](#)) and **NeuPSIG** (contact blake.grimm@iasp-pain.org). A valid membership ID is required.

² Participants qualify as **Trainees** if their degree was obtained no more than five years ago or if their employer confirms that they are still in training. Proof of status is required either by downloading the required form, having it signed by the employer, and submitting it, or by uploading a certificate stating the last degree with the date.

³ Participants qualify for the **Low Income Countries** Category if they reside in a country classified as low-income or lower-middle-income according to the **World Bank**.

Contents of the application

Registration for the event generally includes the following services and content:

Continued medical education credits

Participants have the opportunity to collect continuing education points [CME] as part of the event. However, they are responsible for finding out in advance about the exact conditions and

requirements for earning these points. This includes, in particular, recognition by the relevant chambers or institutions.

The organizers publish the number of continuing education points to be acquired and inform all participants about the corresponding accreditation procedure on the [event website](#). It is the responsibility of the participants to submit the required evidence in due form and to fulfil the respective participation requirements.

Limited access

In the event that the registration is not accepted by the organizer, the participant will be notified immediately.

If a limited number of participants is planned for an event or a program item and the maximum capacity has been reached, the organizer reserves the right to reject registrations or individual bookings. In such a case, the participant's payment will be refunded in full. Participants will be informed immediately of the rejection of their registration.

6. Rights and obligations of participants

Consent

We reserve the right to use photos and moving images taken during the event.

The recordings may be published by the event or its representatives on the event website, on the organizers' social media channels or in other related publications.

If recordings of content are offered by the organizers and the respective presenters have given their consent, these may be published at a later date. Any further distribution, reproduction or other use of these recordings by participants is expressly prohibited.

The content presented and the lectures given are the intellectual property of the respective authors. The organizers ask participants to refrain from making audio or video recordings out of respect for the professional work of the speakers.

Participants who submit or present materials as part of the event guarantee that they hold the corresponding rights of use and copyrights. The organizer accepts no liability for any infringement of these rights.

Data protection

The data of the participant or contractual partner will be stored and processed in electronic form exclusively for the purpose of holding and following up on the event. Data will only be passed on to third parties if the relevant consent has been given.

It should be noted that a separate privacy policy is available, which must be expressly agreed to during registration. This describes in detail how the data is processed.

Cancellation policy

According to § 312g BGB there is no right of withdrawal, as this is a service with a fixed date. Cancellations are only possible in accordance with the cancellation conditions.

Changes and cancellations

In the event of force majeure, the organizers reserve the right to change the format of the event to a fully virtual format. As a consequence, all pre-registered participants for the face-to-face event will automatically be rebooked for online participation.

If the event cannot take place on site as planned, the organizers also reserve the right to change the date of the event. In this case, participants will be informed of the changes immediately.

In the event of a complete cancellation of the event due to force majeure, the participation fees already paid will be refunded. Only the administrative costs already incurred will be deducted from the refund.

The organizers assume no responsibility for any additional costs or damages that participants may incur in connection with a change of event format or date.

Disclaimer
